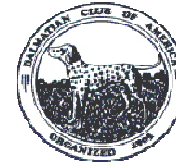

- Friday and Sunday: Dogs will be run low to high.
- Saturday: Dogs will be run high to low.
- Standard Classes will run as Exc Std, Open Std, Novice Std
- JWW Classes will run as, Novice JWW, Open JWW and Excellent JWW
- Preferred classes will be run in conjunction with regular classes at the end of the jump heights.

**Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breeds and breeds not registerable with the AKC are not eligible. Refer to Chapter 3, Section 22 of the Dog Show Rules. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dogs shows are eligible to participate (effective 1/1/98 - Section 4 of the Agility Regulations).

**Moving Up To The Next Class**

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing **no later than the Monday, July 27th at 6:00 pm**. Move-ups over the weekend will be accommodated, provided the information is provided before the trial ends each day.

**Prizes and Awards**

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. New Titling Ribbons offered for those finishing a title. Special MACH ribbons will also be provided. Toys one per dog exhibiting will be offered.

## Notice To Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes may **not** run in a higher height division.
- **Bitches in season and injured dogs** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$10 processing fee per day entered **with a certificate from a veterinarian**.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs**. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. **Please** help us keep this site clean future use.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
- Concessions will be available on site.
- **The show site will be available to exhibitors for set up after 3:00pm on Thursday. Exhibitors will NOT be allowed to set up in the building before this time. No exceptions.**
- RVs may come any time after 3:00 pm on Thursday.

### Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through period allows handlers to plan their strategy running the course and will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing.

The person who submits the entry is responsible for entering at the correct jump height. If no height card or measurement form is included with the entry or presented at check-in, dog must be measured before it can compete, except 24" & 26" class dogs unless a VMO or Rep is present.

#### **DIRECTIONS TO MTSU ARENA**

From I-24: Exit 78 (Franklin/96 and Lebanon)- exit the interstate going toward Murfreesboro(east). This is Old Fort Parkway and will become Memorial Blvd/Hwy 231. Go until you get to the intersection of Memorial and Clark Blvd. (BP gas and U-Haul on corner). Turn right on Middle Tenn Blvd, go to Greenland Dr. and turn left. Parking in front of the arena is on the right past the 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light.

From I-40: From west or east take the Lebanon exit for Highway 231 and go south toward Murfreesboro (from Nashville turn right, from Knoxville turn left). This will become Memorial Blvd when you get into Murfreesboro. Go to the intersection of Memorial and Middle Tenn Blvd and turn left. Go to Greenland Dr. and turn left. Parking in front of the arena is on the right past the 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light.

**Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.**

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
