All levels of Standard and JWW, all levels of T2B and FAST, all Preferred classes will run with the Regular classes. Both trials will run concurrently: FAST (trial 2) will be run first in Ring 1, followed by Time to Beat (trial 1) in Ring 2, E/M Standard in Ring 1, E/M JWW in Ring 2, etc., with all remaining classes alternating rings.

Check-in will begin at 7:30 am and judging will begin promptly at 8:00 am.

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 50 runs online (50%), 50 runs paper (50%) each trial. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

- Three Bulls Farm has an indoor arena with sand fiber flooring. Limited viewing area in the arena.
- There is PA system that projects outside the arena and towards the barns. The bathrooms are in the end of the nearest barn.
- Competitors can crate out of your vehicle or rent a stall in the nearby barns. There will also be an area for crates near the rings. This is a working farm. There are no dogs allowed off leash, unless actively running a course in the arena.
- No smoking / vaping / or any other form of smoking inside or near the arena or barns.

Please stay away from livestock and pick up after your dogs.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The GDCA and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The GDCA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the GDCA or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Refunds are not issued for less than \$10. No refunds will be issued other than for bitches in season.

BITCHES IN SEASON will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$5 per trial processing fee, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This club agrees to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Jump Height Cards

The entry form has a spot to indicate if the dog needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running. The jump height box on the entry form **MUST** be filled in. For more information on jump height cards and the measuring process, please go to www.pawsabilitiestn.com.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: These trials are open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). **Entry is further limited to Great Danes only.**

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these

regulations it includes both sexes. This Event is NOT accepting entries for mixed breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place on Sand fiber flooring. Electronic timers will be used. The rings for all classes will be approximately 100 ft x 100 ft.

All express mail must be able to be left at the Secretary's address with no acceptance signature required. Hand deliveries will not be accepted during the first 24 hours following the trial's opening. **PLEASE do not staple** your check to the entry form. Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations **MUST be received in writing** prior to the September 30 2026, closing date, be legible and include the AKC number, or no refund will be issued. No telephone changes accepted.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be made on official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. GDCA is not offering an extended wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time.

AGILITY INVITATIONAL EVENT

The top-ranked Great Danes in **Novice, Open, Excellent and Master Agility, in both the Regular and Preferred classes**, have been invited to compete in the 2026 GDCA Agility Invitational.

Invitational exhibitors must enter **Standard and Jumpers with Weaves in Trial 1** of the GDCA National Specialty Agility Trial. Exhibitors must enter the class in which they qualified for the Invitational unless they are no longer eligible to compete in that class under AKC rules. In that case, they must enter the next eligible class or the class in which they are currently competing.

The Invitational score will be based on the **two Trial 1 scores: Standard and Jumpers with Weaves**. The average of those two scores will be the dog's final Invitational score. A non-qualifying score will be counted as zero. Regular and Preferred competitors will compete within their respective Invitational classes.

The highest-scoring Great Dane in each Invitational class will be designated the **2026 GDCA Agility Invitational Champion** for that class and will receive a Champion rosette. All Invitational exhibitors will receive a participation rosette. In the event of a tie, placement will be determined by the dog's ranking during the Invitational qualification period.

Specific Invitational entry requirements and rules were provided with the invitations.

CONFIRMATIONS: If you provide a valid, legible, unblocked email address, your entries will be acknowledged via email when received. Final confirmation and a judging schedule will also be sent via email—you will NOT receive a confirmation via US mail. If you do not provide an email address, your confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be mailed to the address provided on your entry form. If you have not received a copy of your confirmation five days before the show, please contact the Trial Secretary.

MOVE-UPS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of an agility title earned after closing, however move-up requests must be made in writing (email request is acceptable) and must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than Monday, October 12, 2026, at 6pm per AKC regulations. They may be e-mailed to jebmohr@gmail.com. Provide dog's call name, owner's name, original class entered and new class requested. Dogs moved up will generally be placed at the end of the running order if armband numbers have already been assigned. No move-ups are allowed day of trials since trials will be run concurrently.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings, may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulations agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES: Only qualifying scores are eligible for ribbons, awards, and prizes. All ribbons, awards, and prizes must be claimed the day of the trial; none will be mailed.

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each Standard, JWW, and FAST class as follows for 1st-4th place:

First Place.....	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow

Fourth Place.....White
Qualifying Score.....Dark Green Rosette

A ribbon will be awarded in each Time2Beat class for first place.

New Title rosettes will be available for new titles earned at these trials.

Double Q rosettes will be available for dogs earning a qualifying score in both Master Standard and Master JWW classes at the same trial.

Special MACH and PACH rosettes, along with a MACH/PACH pole, will be available for dogs earning those titles at these trials.

A large rosette for AGCH will be available for any dogs achieving this title at these trials.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same

dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO will be open for all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying, and will be marked in the catalog as “Absent”.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

FEO Runs will be offered for all classes.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
