**◆◆ The Trial Site will be available to exhibitors for set-up after 3:00 p.m. CST on Wednesday, January 26, 2011. No crate or dollies may be brought in through the front door. Do NOT crate in front of fire extinguishers.**

- Obedience trial entry fees include a 50¢ AKC first entry Recording Fee and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. Rally trial entry fees include a \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee.
- Make checks payable to NDTC. Please typewrite or print all information required on entry forms.
- Incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and cannot be entered in the show. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Email changes must be made to the Secretary at: [junej@esarch.com](mailto:junej@esarch.com). **Changes by phone are NOT acceptable.**
- Please note to waive signature if sending by express or overnight mail. Postdated or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A fee of \$30 will be charged for all returned checks. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
