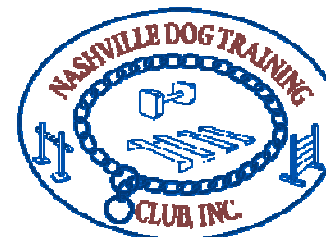

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained a PAL or ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Moving Up To The Next Class

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing no later than Monday, January 25th at 6:00 pm. Move-ups during the trials will be accommodated, provided the information is provided before the trial ends each day. Per AKC regulations, **if you forget to move up prior to the deadline**, you may not move up until the 2nd day you are showing. So if you show Friday through Sunday, you may submit a move up on Friday for Saturday and Sunday, but will not be allowed to move up for Friday.

Entry Confirmation

Due to the prevalence of spam filters and the instability of email, email confirmations are no longer entirely reliable. Therefore, while email confirmations will still be sent, if you would like acknowledgement that your entry was received and accepted, please include a self-stamped, addressed postcard, and do not send an email inquiring if your entry was accepted.

If you are willing to accept partial entries (i.e. if your dog gets in Thursday and Sunday only), please indicate that on your entry form. Exhibitors who are placed on a waiting list will be informed of their position on the wait list, and will be informed immediately of their acceptance into the trial as it occurs.

Entry tips

Want to make a Trial Secretary's life easier? Processing entries for a trial is tedious at best, and the way we receive some entries can make our job even more difficult. So, if you care about the sanity of your trial secretary, please follow these tips:

- Please don't staple your check to the entry form. Use a paper clip to attach it to your entries.
- Please include a copy of your height card. Trial secretaries are no longer allowed to keep them in the database. **Please cut your height card down to size and staple it to the back of the form**, but please don't staple it to the front and cover the information we need to input.
- Please write legibly!
- Please double check the total due before writing the check.
- Make sure you submit both sides of the form. Your signature on the front indicates that you agree with the verbiage on the back. **This is required by AKC and any unsigned entries or entries without the agreement on the back may not be accepted and must be returned.**

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. New Titling Ribbons, PAX and MACH ribbons offered for those finishing a title.

Toys will be given to each dog entered for the weekend, valued at \$4 or less.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through period allows handlers to plan their strategy running the course and will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing.

Measuring

If you have a valid jump height card or a signed measurement form, please send a photocopy with your entry to avoid check-in at the trials. The person who submits the entry is responsible for entering at the correct jump height. If no height card or measurement form is included with the entry or presented at check-in, dog must be measured before it can compete, except 24" & 26" class dogs unless a VMO or Rep is present.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Notice To Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- The trial-giving club, the Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- **Bitches in season and injured dogs** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Partial refund (less \$5 administration fee per day) will be given with letter from veterinarian.
- At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat buckle collars, but there shall be no hanging tags or attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs**. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. **Please** help us keep this site clean to allow our continued future use.
- The show site will be available to exhibitors for set up after 3:00 pm on Wednesday, January 27th.
- We are expecting an increase in the obedience entries due to the fact that it is a regional obedience trial. Crating will be tight, therefore **mats and oversized chairs will NOT be permitted** and ex-pens will only be allowed for two or more dogs. The trial committee will be assisting exhibitors with set-up to maximize space. Please stack crates if possible.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Chairman will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
