Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FFO Runs will be offered for all classes.

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. As of 7/1/24, FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying and will be marked as Absent in the catalog.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

SPECIAL AGILITY PRIZES MACH4 High Flyer Ceridwen CD, TD Memorial Challenge Trophy

Honoring Ceri, the first Pembroke Welsh Corgi to earn a MACH, the trophy is a framed glass mosaic depicting Ceri performing the weave poles during her MACH run. Created and donated to the PWCCA by Yvette Huesler, the mosaic sits in a solid walnut base harvested, designed and constructed by Mark Duberstein. This trophy is awarded annually at the Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club of America National Specialty Agility Trial. It is awarded to the Pembroke Welsh Corgi that qualifies from both the Excellent/Masters Standard and the Excellent/Masters Jumpers with Weaves classes (preferred classes are not eligible), with the combined most yards per second as determined by the agility trial secretary computer program. For permanent possession, the trophy must be won three times by the identical owner(s), not necessarily with the same dog. The trophy will remain in the possession of the club until it is won outright. Retired in September 2019 by MACH3 Cibola True Enough HSAs, The Ceri Challenge Trophy was re-donated by Cibola Kennel, Cindy Traylor and Maureen Flaherty. A certificate, rosette and 10" Pewter Apple Bowl will be awarded to the winner.

Agility Preferred Award

An Agility Preferred Annual Award is to be given at each PWCCA National Specialty. This award will be offered by the PWCCA and awarded to the Pembroke Welsh Corgi that qualifies from both Excellent/Masters Standard Preferred and the Excellent/Masters Jumpers With Weaves Preferred classes with the combined most yards per second as determined by the agility trial secretary computer program. The winner will receive a rosette and a pewter bowl with the PWCCA seal.

Decorated MACH & PACH bars provided by the PWCCA will be presented to dogs completing those titles.

If using your GPS: Some GPS's bring you off Sparta pike to Beech Log. That is very winding back way, and it's easy to get lost. It's easier to enter the coordinates for the corner of Beech Log Rd and Cainsville Rd:

From Franklin / 840:

Take exit 65 (TN 452E). Turn right.

Travel 4.4 miles to Highway 231N (TN 452E ends at the stop sign). Turn left.

Travel 5.8 miles to TN 265E (Chicken Road). Turn right.

Travel 5.4 miles to TN 266S (Cainesville Pike). Turn right.

Travel 1.4 miles to Beech Log Road. Turn left.

Travel 2.5 miles to show site on the left, 3337 Beech Log Road.

From Murfreesboro:

Welcome to Never Go Back Ranch!

Unlike many agility venues, Never Go Back is a working farm as well as Kellie and Tim's home. We're glad you're here, but we ask you to please observe the following rules while you're with us.

- Please DRIVE SLOWLY, 5 mph or less, at all times while you are on the property! There are chickens, geese, and ducks who roam the property freely.
- 2. **Please do not arrive before 7:00**. This will give time for the farm chores to be completed before you arrive.
- 3. Please park as directed. We have a lot of people to fit in and very limited parking. If you park without direction, you will most likely be asked to move.
- 4. Please obey posted "No Dogs" signs. This will include pastures where livestock are kept as well as the area near the house.
- 5. Please leave all the farm animals alone sheep, cows, and fowl. They are easily spooked and can hurt themselves if harassed. Livestock are expensive to replace.
- 6. All exhibitors except the trial committee will need to crate out of your car. Please don't block gates or doors. If you're unsure where to park, ask Kellie.
- 7. Please pick up after your dog! Always.
- 8. Dogs must be on lead at all times when not in the ring or using the practice jump. This is an AKC rule and will be strictly enforced.
- 9. There is no spectator seating in the arena. If your dog is not running in the next 3 dogs, please do not enter the arena. If you want to watch runs, please do so from the hallway and maintain social distancing. You can also watch from under the tents at the windows in front. A duplicate version of the gate check in sheet will be outside to help limit the number of people in the arena.

Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. Thes dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
